Count the entry fee according to the show flyer, DO does not recognize memberships).

Please note this is just a plan, change can occur, depending on number of dogs entered!

Tail docking is not forbidden in the Czech Republic!!! Docked dogs are allowed to participate in all events.

Titles (including unofficial):

The Best Baby, the Best Puppy, BOJ (Best of Juniors), BOV (Best of Veterans), CAJC, CAC, Res.CAC, ČKŠ, Best Male/Female, BOB, BOS, **Australian Shepherds:** BIS in color, **Belgian Shepherds:** BIS baby, BIS puppy, BIS junior, BIS veterans, BIS working classes, BIS honorary classes, BIS.

Award of titles is not pretended. The title for ČKŠ (waiter for Club Champion) is conditioned with a membership in the KCHBO Club.

Classes:

Baby - 4 - 6 months (males and females)

Puppy - 6 - 9 months (males and females)

Junior - 9 - 18 months (males and females)

Intermediate - 15 - 24 months (males and females)

Open - from 15 months (males and females)

Working - from 15 months (males and females) dogs shall only be registered as such, if the required Working Certificates have been issued and attached to the entry form.

Winners - from 15 months (males and females), dogs shall only be registered as such, if the recognized title has been awarded (InterChampion, Champion, National Winner, Club Winner, Winner of the Specialty Show). The title needs to be achieved in the adult competition.

Veterans - from 8 years (males and females)

Honorary - 15 months (males and females), dogs shall only be registered as such, if the recognized title has been awarded (InterChampion, Champion, National Winner, Club Winner, Winner of the Specialty Show), European Winner, World Winner), CAC is not awarded in this class.

For classification of the dog in to the class, **the age at the day** when the Show is held is decisive. Other conditions have to be fulfilled at the day of entry.

A copy of said Certificate must be enclosed with the Entry Form. If the Certificate is missing, the dog will be entered in Open class. Honorary class is unofficial class and results from this class are not recorded in the dog's pedigree.

Competitions:

Best Couple - for male and female belonging to the same owner, which were evaluated at the Show. Couple can't be related i.e. littermates or siblings or parents and offsprings.

Best Kennel - shall consist of minimum 3 dogs and maximum 5 dogs from the same Kennel, from minimum two different Sires or Dams. Dogs must have been evaluated at the Show (does not need to be owned by the breeder).

Best Stud - for a Stud male and 3 - 5 descendants out of minimal two Dams evaluated at this Show (the Stud male does not need to be evaluated at the Show, but he must be presented in the competition)

Best Brood Bitch - for a Brood Bitches and 3 - 5 descendants out of minimal two Sires, evaluated at this Show (the female does not need to be evaluated at the Show, but she must be presented in the competition)

Child & Dog - for children at the age from 3 - 9 years

Awards:

Each Showed dog obtains a judge report and diploma. Winners of titles and competitions obtain prizes.

Sponsorship:

Documents needed to participate at the Show:

- Pedigree of the dog officially issued by Stud Book accepted by FCI
- Confirmation of registration (will be sent at least 7 days before the Show by email or by post – please mark in the entry for otherwise it will be send via email)
- Pet passport or vaccination book with proper vaccination

Veterinary Conditions:

All the participating dogs must be healthy. Dogs living in the Czech Republic have to have vaccination book (according to the § 6 of the Veterinary Law) or Pet Passport for small animals. Dogs from EU countries have to be accompanied with valid Pet Passport (according to § 6 of the CZ Veterinary Law). Dogs from other countries have to fulfill conditions given by European Parliament and European committee no 998/2003 from 26.5.2003. All animals older than 6 months must have valid rabies vaccination and also confirmation about this vaccination in accordance with § 4 article 1, letter f) of the Veterinary Law (as valid is accepted the basic vaccination after 21 days from the day it was applied. Also as valid is accepted the re-vaccination within the effectiveness of the previous used vaccine). Dogs have to be in the immunity against parvovirus and distemper (as valid is accepted the vaccination after 21 days from the moment it was applied unless it is applied within validity of the previous one). Dogs which will not pass veterinary control may not participate at the Show.

General rules:

All males and females of Belgian Shepherd and Australian Shepherd are accepted at the Show. They must be registered in the Stud Book accepted by FCI, achieved given age at the day when the Show is held for classification. The Show committee can reject to accept entry without giving any reason. But needs to inform the exhibitor about this fact within 10 days after entry application delivery. If not state otherwise, the rules of ČMKU will apply. The organizer of the Show is not responsible for damage caused by a dog or an exhibitor, not even for a death or a loss of a dog. The owner is responsible for all damages caused by his/ her dog(s). Free running of a dog is forbidden. The dogs not published in the catalogue, sick dogs or suspected sick dogs, after injury, females in heat, females in lactation or second half of pregnancy, dogs owned by the person(s) who are banned from the showing, dangerous or aggressive dogs (toward human or other dogs) are excluded from the Show. Owners of dogs are necessary to keep the place clean and are not allowed to damage the place. Sale of puppies is forbidden at the Show premises. Law ČNR no.246/1992 Sb for animal protection against torture in whole extension has to be observed. In case of not holding the Show for objective reasons (infection, etc.), the fees will be used to reimburse the costs in connection with the preparation of the Show. In case there is more than one owner, only one contact address will be published in the catalogue.

Protests:

Protests against decision of judges are not admitted. Protests are allowed only for formal reasons, against breaking rules and propositions. Protest must be given in a written form together with the fee in an amount of double entry fee for the first dog on the first deadline with and only in the time of course of the Show. Protest given after the ring judging is finished will not be handled. If the protest is not accepted, the sum will forfeit to the Show organizers.

Collecting of DNA samples for DNA profile

During the Sunday (31.05.2015) morning (before judging will start) there will be possibility to have the DNA samples collected. The fee for the DNA profile needs to be paid in advance. In case when both parents already have their DNA profiles please bring their protocols so the parentage can be verified too.

Entry Fees:

When the owner enters two or more dogs - we cannot consider the dog entered to the following classes: baby, puppy, veteran, honorary to be the first dog in any case.
